MNTRAC CLEAN UP!!!!

Paxlovid Patient Assistance Programs

No patient should be paying full price for Paxlovid.

- Using the PAXCESS program, Paxlovid is \$0 for any patient with public insurance such as Medicare (regardless of Part D or other prescription plans) or Medicaid, or the uninsured.
- PAXCESS also provides a copay card of up to \$1500 for any patient with private insurance.
- The patient, caregiver, prescriber, or pharmacist can enroll a patient in the program and it only takes 5 minutes.

MDH has created a poster/flyer for display in patient care areas with a link to enroll in PAXCESS. [Click here](#) to view the poster/flyer.

- Suggested areas for display include (but are not limited to): outpatient clinics, urgent care clinics, emergency departments, pharmacies, and COVID-19 testing locations.

Action item: MDH is asking facilities to print and distribute the poster and/or flyers in all relevant areas with high patient visibility.

- WHEN: March 28, 2024
0900 - 1330
- **Registration Required – by February 15, 2024**
- Hospitals are asked to invite their partners to participate in their facility command center – partners may include:
 - Local/County Emergency Manager
 - Local public health
 - EMS
 - Fire
- **ONLY** Hospitals need to register (other participants will be recorded on the day of the exercise – at the hospital command center)
- ***Note: Each facility needs a controller/evaluator and a communications lead. These are 2 separate roles and will require 2 different individuals.***

What does a PAPR do?

- PAPR – Powered Air Purifying Respirator
 - Battery powered blower supplies a headcover or hood with filtered air
- Direct replacement for an N-95 respirator
- Used to filter biological particles such as bacteria and viruses

Why does my site need a PAPR?

- Used for those that are not fit testable
 - Those that have failed a multitude of fit test attempts
 - Those that have religious reasons for facial hair
 - Those that are not fit-tested, this would be great for just-in-time protection needs, weekends, holidays, evenings, etc.

 - August 26th-29th,
 - October 28th-31st.
