

Storm #1 - Snow Tonight

Broad swath of 2-5" likely over much of central-southern MN into western WI

Key Messages


- A swath of 2-5" of snow is expected across the region beginning later today and ending Friday morning.
- The highest amounts will be along I-94, and also along/east of I-35.
- Plan on travel impacts tonight into the Friday morning commute as temperatures drop into the mid 20s.
- Winds will be less than 20 mph, so blowing snow shouldn't be an issue with this system.

What Has Changed

The double banded snowfall scenario seems more likely, and as a result snowfall amounts have decreased a bit but become more widespread.

Storm #1 - Timing and Impacts


Timing

- A few snow showers today, but the accumulating snow begins later this afternoon across western Minnesota.
- Snow will become more widespread across the region this evening.
- The heaviest snow will fall tonight.
- Snow will end from west to east Friday morning.

Impacts

- Ground temperatures will be cold enough for snow to accumulate.
- Roads will become slippery this evening through Friday morning.



Storm #1 - Snowfall Rates

Snowfall Rates

- Snowfall rates will generally be 1/2 to 1 in/hr.
- The gray/blue shading shows a chance (10 to 30%) that rates could exceed 1 in/hr along I-94 tonight, with another area along I-90 early Friday morning.

Forecast Details

- No significant changes.
- Temperatures will be at or below freezing as the snow falls, with subfreezing temperatures lingering into Friday morning.
- Temperatures will warm above freezing on Friday afternoon, which should help plowed surfaces recover.

Forecast Details

- No significant changes.
- Winds will be out of the east at 10 to 15 mph, with gusts near 20 mph at times.
- The risk for blowing snow is low at these speeds.

Storm #1 - Winter Weather Advisory


Advisory begins 7pm Thursday, ends 10am Friday.

Key Messages

• Winter Weather Advisory was expanded a few counties to the south and west.

Timing

- The Winter Weather Advisory will go into effect this evening and last into Friday morning.
- The heaviest snow will be between 8PM and 4AM (from west to east), but travel impacts will linger into Friday morning.

A second, larger system will impact the region Sunday and could last into Tuesday.

Storm #2 - Sunday into Tuesday

Key Messages

- A second, more significant winter storm will impact the Upper Midwest Sunday through Tuesday.
- This is a dynamic system. The track, temperatures, and rain/snow amounts are going to change with every update. (next slide)
- Confidence remains high in broad swath of 6"+ of snow, possibly mixed with rain/sleet (see map), along with strong easterly winds of 25 to 35 mph.


Impacts

Travel will be the primary impact, but the power grid may also be impacted depending on how much falls as ice versus snow.

What To Do

- Stay tuned to updates and use reliable sources for forecast information.
- Don't focus on specific totals. Snow amounts and location will vary a lot when the storm is this far out into the future.







Uncertainty

- Confidence is high in accumulating snow on Sunday.
- Confidence remains low Sunday night, Monday and Tuesday.
 - There is uncertainty where the storm will Ο track and how fast it will move.
 - As a result, precipitation amount and type Ο (rain, ice, or snow) is uncertain.







Storm #2 - Temperatures & Winds

Temperatures will gradually warm above freezing Sunday night into Monday.


