# **Snow Tonight & This Weekend**

#### **Key Messages:**

Storm #1 - There will be a few snow showers today, but the heavier snow remains on track for later this evening and overnight. The Winter Weather Advisory was expanded a bit to include more counties. As of 5AM, the chance for getting Warning Snow (6" or more) has decreased slightly but is still non-zero.

Storm #2 - A prolonged and stronger winter storm remains likely for us beginning Sunday and lingering through Monday night or Tuesday morning. Confidence is still low in terms of exact snow amounts as we have potential for multiple precipitation types depending on where the system tracks.



# Is MNTrac a part of your Emergency Planning?

Consider adding a statement such as the following to your communications plan:

"MNTrac is a State of MN program utilized to identify bed availability in both hospitals and long-term care. If there is a need for our facility to request assistance with resident placement/movement, we would reach out to the [West Central or Central] Healthcare Preparedness Coalition to request such assistance. That assistance will include sending out a bed alert to all appropriate facilities to identify availability."





# Free Fit Testing Medical Clearance Opportunity for Long Term Care

Minnesota Department of Health has temporary resources available for **FREE** medical clearance evaluations to long term care facility staff. Per OSHA, medical clearance evaluations are required prior to N95 fit-testing.

#### **OSHA FIRST RECEIVER TRAINING**

- On-line modular training offered by coalition in 2024:
  - August 26<sup>th</sup>-29<sup>th</sup>,
  - October 28<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup>.
- Sessions will be offered 0800-1000 or 2000-2200 each day, attendees must attend 1 session per day for the entire 4-day period (8-hours total).
- This training will get the attendee a FEMA certificate of completion
- 3-hour Fee for service hands on sessions can be scheduled after if desired by your agency/facility (not required)
