- On-line modular training offered by coalition in 2024:
 - August 26th-29th, 2024
 - October 28th-31st, 2024
 - January 20-23rd, 2025
 - March 24th-27th, 2025
- Sessions will be offered 0800-1000 or 2000-2200 each day, attendees must attend 1 session per day for the entire 4-day period (8-hours total).
- This training will get the attendee a FEMA certificate of completion

A webinar, on May 13, 2024, from 1:00-2:00 PM EDT / 10:00-11:00 AM PDT, will provide information on the many NWS heat-related products and services issued across the agency, covering a continuum of timescales. The webinar will cover current operational heat-related products from the Climate Prediction Center, Weather Prediction Center, and local Weather Forecast Offices, and will detail the future plans and initiatives related to heat.
