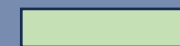

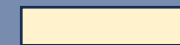

# CYBER SECURITY UPDATE



Information contained in this slide comes from Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency (CISA) and the Health Sector Cybersecurity Coordination Center (HC3) of the Department of Health and Human Services.

Due to the increase in cyber attacks and threats, the healthcare coalition has created this page to alert its members to noted issues and other pertinent information. Please make sure that this information is shared with the appropriate IS/IT individuals.

Seashell Blizzard is a cyber threat group believed to be associated with Russian intelligence agencies, particularly with Unit 74455, the Main Center for Special Technologies within the Main Directorate of the General Staff of the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation. The group has been operating since at least 2009 and has been implicated in numerous high profile cyberattacks targeting governments, critical infrastructure, and organizations across the globe. During the ongoing conflict in Ukraine, much of the group's focus has been aimed toward disrupting Ukrainian operations and trying to obtain battlefield advantages; however, they have displayed a willingness and capability to shift this focus to benefit Russia's broader national interests. Seashell Blizzard will continue to pose a threat to cyber operations globally, and should be considered a significant threat to the Healthcare and Public Health (HPH) sector.

CISA has added three new vulnerabilities to its [Known Exploited Vulnerabilities Catalog](#), based on evidence of active exploitation.

- [CVE-2022-24816](#) GeoSolutionsGroup JAI-EXT Code Injection Vulnerability
- [CVE-2022-2586](#) Linux Kernel Use-After-Free Vulnerability
- [CVE-2020-13965](#) Roundcube Webmail Cross-Site Scripting (XSS) Vulnerability

These types of vulnerabilities are frequent attack vectors for malicious cyber actors and pose significant risks to the federal enterprise.
